

AUTHORIZATION OF MEDICAL TREATMENT

Parent/legal guardian must complete & sign

I, legal guardian and/or parent of _____ (print child's full name), hereby authorize and give my consent that in my absence and ability to be reached or be present that the above named minor be admitted to any hospital or medical facility for diagnosis and treatment. In the event of an emergency, I authorize the transportation of my child via ambulance and any and all medical treatment by ambulance staff and all emergency personnel. I hereby request and authorize any physicians, dentists, medical staff, duly licensed as Doctors of Medicine or Doctors of Dentistry or other such licensed technicians, hospital staff, medical staff, or nurses, to perform any diagnostic procedures, treatment procedures, operative procedures, x-ray procedures or any and all medically necessary procedures on the above minor. I hereby authorize that in my absence or inability to be reached that the Maria Kaupas Center (MKC) or its representative be granted the authority to make any and all necessary medical decisions (using best judgment and upon advice of such medical or emergency personnel) for my minor child and hereby agree to hold the Maria Kaupas Center and/or its personal representatives, agents, assigns, and/or directors harmless for the resulting consequences of such decisions.

I recognize that as a result of medical treatment and care, costs may be incurred. I hereby recognize and acknowledge any medical payments and/or costs for such medical treatment incurred, including but not limited to deductibles, medical services, prescriptions, and co-payments, are my responsibility. I agree that under no circumstances will I seek any contribution from the Maria Kaupas Center, their insurer or hold them responsible for any costs as a result of medical expenses occurred for care and treatment.

CODE OF CONDUCT:

Both scholars and parents/legal guardians must read and sign below

- All participants are expected to show respect to each other as well as to the MKC staff, facility, and equipment. Each participant will be held responsible for his/her actions and behavior. Uncooperative participants may be asked to leave.
- Drugs, alcohol, and tobacco products are not allowed within the facility or on the grounds. Anyone in attendance or attempting to enter who is under the influence or in possession of alcohol, illegal drugs or illicit substances will be asked to leave. Parents and/or police will be notified.
- Weapons and items that may be considered weapons are forbidden. Anyone found to be in possession of such items will be required to leave and items will be confiscated. This includes laser pointers. Parents and/or police will be notified as appropriate.
- Violence or threats of violence will not be tolerated within the facility, on the grounds, or at MKC sponsored events.
- Food and beverages must be kept in designated areas.
- Any damage to MKC property will be paid for by the person responsible.
- Use of abusive, obscene, or profane language, including racial, religious, or sexual references directed at others, will not be tolerated. Please remember to treat others as you would like to be treated.
- Inappropriate or disruptive behavior is not permitted in the facility. This includes but is not limited to graffiti, littering, spitting, or throwing objects.
- No teen shall commit any act which furthers or promotes gangs or gang-related activities. This includes but is not limited to wearing, displaying, or distributing any clothing, jewelry, symbols or other items which may be evidence of membership in any gang.
- All who enter the Maria Kaupas Center are expected to comply with the Code of Conduct standards. Anyone who disrupts the operations of the Center may be asked to leave the property. MKC staff has the authority to prohibit such persons from attending future events.

STUDENT CODE OF CONDUCT CONSEQUENCES:

AGREEMENT AND ACKNOWLEDGEMENT

If code of conduct is broken, the following actions will be taken in this order:

- Student will receive 2 verbal warnings.
- If code of conduct is broken a 3rd time, the student will be asked to clean in the center for 30 minutes (sweeping, dusting etc.)

- If student misses the assigned cleaning duty, he/she will be suspended from the MKC until the duty is complete.
- If student behavior continues not to represent the values of the MKC, a parent conference will be scheduled.
- If student behavior continues not to represent the values of the MKC after a parent conference, the student will be asked to no longer attend the center until staff states otherwise.

RELEASE AGREEMENT:

BOTH SCHOLAR & PARENT/LEGAL GUARDIAN must read and sign below:

In consideration of participation at the Maria Kaupas Center (MKC), I undersigned (as legal representative and/or guardian) and student, hereby agree to indemnify and hold harmless and covenant not to sue the MKC and hereby waive, release, and discharge them from any and all claims for loss or damage, death, personal or bodily injury, or property damage which I may have or which hereinafter may accrue to me against the MKC, its employees, agents, assigns, volunteers, directors, and for any liability arising out of or connected in any way with my preparation with the MKC. The undersigned hereby agree to indemnify and hold harmless and release from all liability, claims, demands, causes of action, charges, expenses, and attorney fees resulting from involvement in any activity at the MKC or involvement with the MKC, whether caused by negligent acts or omission of the releases otherwise. It is further understood and agreed that this waiver and release has been entered freely and will be binding upon me and my heirs and assigns. The undersigned expressly agree that the foregoing release and waiver, indemnity agreement, and assumption of risk are intended to be as broad and inclusive as permitted by Illinois law and that if any portion of this agreement is held valid, void, or unenforceable for any reason, it is agreed that the balance or remainder shall, notwithstanding, continue to be in full legal force and effect.

By signing this application, I understand that my child will be participating in programs at the Maria Kaupas Center. I agree to allow images of my child (video, photo, other digital media) captured during programs to be utilized in printed materials, media materials, or online. I agree to waive any rights of compensation or ownership of these images. My child's name will not be publicized in conjunction with these images, unless an authorized representative of the MKC receives verbal permission. The MKC is not liable for images of your child that are "tagged" by other individuals on social media websites.
